## **REVITALIZING JOINERY**

This is an easy, quick operation which is important in order to preserve the original appearance of the coating film for a long time.

It must be carried out on a coating film which is in a good state, not damaged by scratches, dents and cracks. The purpose is as follows:

- to restore the original appearance of the outer protective layer
- to maintain waterproofing
- to maintain elasticity



## **Procedure**

Thoroughly clean joinery with the Sayerlack Linea Blu **HH 8011** neutral detergent. This does not call for any sanding and is a very simple operation. Use a soft cloth that does not leave behind filaments to apply either Linea Blu **KK 1112** reviving oil or the waterborne product Linea Blu **HH 8012**. Apply the product with circular movements, taking care to remove any excess product. Then allow to dry for several hours before handling the joinery. Caution: when applied to white surfaces Linea Blu **KK 1112** reviving oil tends to turn them yellow. Do not apply too much and do not leave build-ups. The product must be absorbed by the coating film like a cream on skin.



## **How often**

Once a year, after cleaning.



## **Products**

Neutral detergent Linea Blu **HH 8011**, waterborne reviving product Linea Blu **HH 8012**, or solvent-based reviving product **KK 1112**.
